About This Product

Bell's Strong Pholcodine Linctus BP is taken to relieve unproductive coughs.

Liquid for oral use. Read the entire label before taking this medicine. Adults, the elderly and children over 12 years of age: Take one 5ml children over 12 years or age: Take one Smi spoonful. The above dose maybe taken up to 4 times in any 24 hour period. Do not give to children under 12 years. Do not take with other cough and cold medicine.

Do not exceed the stated dose.

Do not use this medicine if you:

Are allergic to any of the ingredients. Have liver disease. Have difficulty breathing, chronic lung conditions or a chest infection that produces lots of phlegm in the chest. Have an asthma attack.

·Are taking MAOI's (monoamine oxidase inhibitors) for depression or within 14 days of stopping.

If you are pregnant or breast-feeding unless your doctor has told you to do so. If used when breast-feeding small amounts of the medicine will be present in your milk.

Caution: This medicine may cause drowsiness, if affected do not drive or operate machinery.

Have a history of asthma or any other breathing problems including bronchitis.

Have had a cough for a long time or a cough that produces lots of phleam.
