## How to use this medicine

- Spray inside your shoes and socks with fungicidal powder perore putting them on.
- Don't wear the same pair of shoes every day. This helps reduce the build-up of sweat which provides the moisture on which the tungus thrives.
- Avoid synthetic footwear. Choose cotton socks and leather shoes which allow your feet to breathe
- Avoid sharing towels or tootwear
- Avoid walking barefoot in changing rooms
- Dry thoroughly between your toes and keep toenails short as this reduces the number of places fungi can grow
