Skin Identical Ceramide complex, Modified Alumino-silicates, Purified water, Glycerol, Glyceryl Stearate, Cocoglycerides, Cetyl Alcohol, Isopropyl Myrisate, Ceteareth-20, Ceteareth-12, Cetearyl Alcohol, Cetyl Palmitate, Dehydroacetic Acid, Benzyl Alcohol, Alkaline earth minerals optimised for atopic eczema treatment.

What is Dermalex Repair Eczema and what is it used for?

- Dermalex Repair Eczema is suitable for people aged 6 years or older suffering from mild or moderate atopic dermatitis symptoms. The product is a topical epidermal barrier damage repair accelerator complex for eczema and is suitable for atopic dermatitis symptoms. It activates the skin's own repair mechanism and creates a barrier on the skin against bacterial toxins and undesirable microorganisms. It moisturises and replenishes the missing natural ceramide components, typical to atopic eczema skin.

 Dermalex Repair is a dermatological product for the treatment of eczema skin symptoms, such as itching, dry skin, red spots, scaling, excoriations, papulation, erosions, oozing and
- induration. The product comes in a cream to be applied on the skin.
- Dermalex Repair is recommended for patients with damaged skin caused by eczema / atopic dermatitis symptoms and for patients aiming to keep their improved dermatitis skin condition under control. Re-apply if symptoms reappear.
- Dermalex Repair Eczema is developed and clinically tested by dermatologists.

What you should know before applying Dermalex Repair Eczema

- Not suitable for children under 6 years old.

 This product **does not** contain Corticosteroids, Calcineurin-inhibitors, artificial colouring and parabens.
- In severe cases, with hyper-acute symptoms of eczema, consult your general practitioner or dermatologist, before beginning the (re)application of Dermalex Repair Eczema.
- No allergic reactions or adverse effects have been reported during or after the clinical observation of this product.
- No contra-indications and/or cross-allergies have been reported during and/or after the clinical observation of this product.
- No major or minor lasting side effects have been reported during and/or after the clinical testing of the product. During the usage of the cream a slight tingling sensation may be felt for a short period of time on application.
- Dermalex Repair Eczema cream does not cause rebound effects upon discontinuation of use. Dermalex causes no thinning of the skin, easy bruising or photo allergic reactions
- If you are using other eczema creams, in order to avoid adverse effects, consult a general practitioner or dermatologist before starting the combination treatment with Dermalex Repair.
- Dermalex Repair does not stain clothing, colour the skin, or cause depigmentation of the skin.

How to apply Dermalex Repair Eczema cream

Always apply Dermalex Repair by following this instruction leaflet. If you have any doubt about these instructions for use, please consult your doctor or pharmacist.

Instructions for use

- Please remove the aluminium seal underneath the screw top before use.
- Carefully clean the affected skin with lukewarm water and if necessary with a special cleaning lotion for skin.
- Apply a thin layer of the cream onto the skin. Repeat the application 2 to 3 times a day (or after bathing, showering or washing hands).
- Dermalex Repair Eczema can be used as often as needed and is suitable for long term use.
- In case of extreme skin dryness or itching, choose a scentless hypoallergenic moisturising cream to cover and soothe the affected area after the application of Dermalex Repair Eczema. For more information: www.dermalex.com

Important information

- During the first 2-3 days of application apply the cream on damp skin. Dermalex Repair Eczema cream is water-soluble. Therefore, always re-apply the cream after washing your hands,
- Do not scratch your itchy skin. Keep your fingernails very short in order to prevent infection and irritation. Do not apply on open wounds or open wounds that are the result of cracking
- Whenever possible wear loose clothing made of natural materials. Natural materials absorb perspiration, body secretions and oily lotions.
- Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact, rinse thoroughly with lukewarm water.

- Dermalex Repair Eczema cream is for external use only.
- Discontinue use and consult your doctor or dermatologist if lasting irritation or allergic reactions occur during or after the application
- Keep out of the reach of babies and children

How to store Dermalex Repair Eczema cream

- Store at room temperature (below 25°C). In order to guarantee its hypoallergenic qualities, Dermalex contains the least possible preservatives and stabilisers.
- Do NOT expose the product to a heating source or direct sunlight! Use before the expiry date indicated on the carton and tube
