

Like all medicines, this medicine can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them. If any of the following or any other side effects occur, stop taking this nedicine and consult a doctor or pharmacist:

abdominal pain, spasms and diarrhoea, in particular these effects may be experienced by patients with irritable colon. In these cases, a reduction in dose may be necessary

and propyl parahydroxybenzoate (E216), which may cause allergic

hypersensitivity (allergic) reactions, hives (skin bumps), skin

itchiness or local or more widespread rash, or asthma. chronic use may lead to albuminuria and haematuria which is albumin (protein) or red blood cells (blood) in the urine.

5. How to store Senokot 7.5mg/5ml Syrup

Keep all medicines out of sight and reach of children.

**Do not** store above 25°C. **Do not** freeze. Do not use after the expiry date shown on the pack. Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment. Each 5ml of Senokot 7.5mg/5ml Syrup contains calcium sennosides equivalent to 7.5mg total sennosides (calculated as Sennoside B). The other ingredients are potassium sorbate (E202), methyl rahydroxybenzoate (E218), propyl parahydroxybenzoate (E216), maltitol liquid (E965), xanthan gum, anti-foam (Medical C) emulsion, prune flavour, citric acid anhydrous and purified water. What Senokot 7.5mg/5ml Syrup looks like and the contents of the pack 150ml bottle.


