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Important information about some of the ingredients

- This product contains 0.47g of sucrose per tablet.
- To be taken into account in people with diabetes.
- If you have an intolerance to some sugars, contact your doctor before taking this medicine.

3. How to use this medicine

Suck or chew the tablets.

A Adults, the elderly and children over 12 Take 1 or 2 tablets when required (maximum 16 per day).

Children 6-12 vrs: Take 1 tablet when required (maximum 4 per day).

Children under 6 years

Do not give to children under 6 unless your doctor tells you to.

If you take too many

If you accidentally take too many tablets, see a doctor straight away. Take the pack with you to show which medicine you have swallowed.

4. Possible side effects

Like all medicines, Setlers Antacid Chewable Tablets can have side effects, although these don't affect everyone.

- May cause stomach problems including wind and constipation.
- May cause a return of acid indigestion after initial relief of symptoms.

If you notice these or any other side effect not included above, stop use and tell your doctor or pharmacist. They will tell you what to do.

Reporting of side effects

If you get any side effects, talk to your doctor, pharmacist or nurse. This includes any possible side effects not listed in this leaflet. You can also report side effects directly via the Yellow Card Scheme at: www.mhra.gov.uk/vellowcard.

By reporting side effects you can help provide more information on the safety of this medicine.

5. Storing this medicine • Keep it out of the sight and reach of children.

- Store in the original pack.
- Do not use after the expiry date shown on the carton. The expiry date refers to the last day of that month.

• Medicine should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of any unused medicine. These measures will help to protect the environment.

What is in this medicine The active ingredient per tablet is: calcium

carbonate 500mg.

The other ingredients are: sucrose, glucose, maize starch, maltodextrin, talc, magnesium stearate, peppermint flavour, adipic acid.

Setlers Antacid Chewable Tablets are round white tablets with bevelled edges and 'Setlers' engraved on both faces. They are supplied in packs of 36 and 96 tablets.
